Ramps for Champs Home Modification Program!

Through partnerships with Federal Home Loan Bank of Atlanta, we are proud to announce a new program being offered by a 501(c)3 not for profit, Friends of Disabled Adults and Children, Too!(FODAC).

FODAC was formed in 1986 for the purpose of providing durable medical equipment and other services at low or no cost to individuals with permanent or temporary disabilities.

FODAC performs home modifications and repair services to accommodate the needs of disabled persons so that they may live safer and more productive lives while residing in their own homes. Such services include the installation of wheel chair ramps, widening of doorways, installing stair lifts, and changing bathroom access and safety.

FODAC’s Ramps for Champs program is now offering accessibility modifications for people with disabilities who qualify in Cobb, Dekalb, Gwinnett, Fulton, Rockdale, Walton, Forsyth, and Cherokee counties to help them remain independent and in their home as long as possible.

This program must ensure that the applicants qualify as low-income households. To qualify as a low-income household the combined annual (gross) income of the applicant and all other persons residing in the household and who are over the age of eighteen (18) years, cannot exceed 50% of the area median income (AMI) adjusted for family size:
